This list is not exhaustive. If in doubt, or your proposed waste stream does not appear on this list, please contact Skip Hire UK to avoid additional incorrect material charges.

Important information:

- Please ensure the location of where the skip is to be placed is accessible for a skip lorry and clear from obstruction for both delivery and collection.
- If we're unable to deliver, collect or need to wait, additional charges are usually applied to cover transport costs.
- Once the skip has been delivered it must not be moved and remains the responsibility of the hirer until the skip has been collected. This extends to any fines incurred due to placement, damage or loss.
- If the skip needs to be placed ON the public highway, you will need to inform us so we can apply for a permit in advance. All permits are chargeable to the customer and will be explained at the point of sale. Should the permit be declined, this charge is NON-REFUNDABLE.
- If the skip is placed OFF the public highway, Skip Hire UK or its contractors are not liable for any damage to property that may be caused.
- All skips placed on the public highway must meet certain criteria explained within the permit. Failure to do so can result in further action from the local authority and/or Highways agency. The hirer accepts no liability for any action taken due to improper use.
- Only use it to dispose of permitted waste types
- Never try to burn items in a skip
- Ensure the skip is level-filled - don't overfill it
